

BOARD POLICY

18 September 2009

1. Any official who is not ready to walk on the court at the prescribed 15 minute mark is late. Notification to the member's division representation in writing is required. If the division representative does not respond within 24 hours, any Board member can be notified. The first offense is public reprimand. The second offense is a \$50 fine. The third offense is a \$75 fine. The fourth and subsequent offenses is a \$100 fine per occurrence.
2. No switching of ball games is permitted. The fine shall be \$25.00 per game. Switch Exception – with the knowledge and approval of the chapter secretary. The Board has final decision whether a switch is made without the secretary's knowledge.
3. All games will be scheduled by the assigning secretary except tournament games from outside source. Tournament games will be treated as chapter assigned games.
4. The chapter and host school/organization will agree on tournament fees. The assignor of the tournament games will give game assignments to chapter secretary and be responsible for payment of proper fees.
5. Refusal to accept assignment from chapter secretary, without good reason, blocks out that date for the official.
6. The Board may appoint a sub-varsity secretary to assist with assignment of sub-varsity games. This position, if appointed, shall be an ex-officio member of the Board without vote and will answer to the chapter secretary.
7. The Board may appoint a web master to assist the treasurer with recording of minutes and posting on the web page. This position shall be an ex-officio member of the Board without vote and will answer to the chapter treasurer.
8. No LBOC member shall officiate in any UIL-sanctioned contest with an individual who is not a UIL recognized chapter. Exception – an employee of the host school district.
9. A member shall attend seventy percent (70%) of chapter meetings in order to remain in good standing. If a member is not in good standing, the Board may impose other penalties. Exception – written notice to the chapter secretary within 48 hours of missed meeting explaining reason for absence. The Board has final approval for acceptance of reason.
10. Any official who misses the deadline for payment of dues 30 days before the state deadline and who wishes to remain an active member shall be charged a total of \$25 reinstatement fee plus state and local annual dues.
11. Any official selected to call any UIL Regional Tournament games must accept within 24 hours of notification. The Board may select a travel agency to make travel plans for all officials. It is strongly suggested that all selected officials will travel together to their respective tournament game site.
12. The Board may remove from office any member of the Board who fails to perform assigned duties and tasks without due cause.
